- → Execution ability

- → Alignment of incentives

(across the whole team incl. advisers, investors, etc.)

PPP

Product, Positioning, Potentia

- → Innovation
- → Competitive advantage
- → Dedicated USP
- → Clear benefits to the user
- → Value-add to Web3
- → Industry/sector/ niche leader potential
- → Go-to-Market strategy
- → Communication strategy

Technology

- → Software quality
- → Git (or other code repository)
- → Number and timing of commits
- → General activity level per team member
- → Infrastructure/ platform choice
- → Tech stack

Token design

Token Economics:

- → **Distribution scheme**to stakeholders
 (e.g., founders, team,
 community, treasury,
 investors, etc.)
- → Founders' long-term goals (beyond own involvement)
- → Release schedule to parties, milestones, multi-sig structures

Token Utility:

- → Token flow model
- → Value accrual mechanisms
- → Token benefit to the network

Legal / Regulatory

- → Deal structure (equity + token or token deal only)




Minimum criteria for a DAO

- Operates on a sufficiently decentralised blockchain protocol
- Secure, shared on-chain account for value storage
- Transactions involving DAO assets must involve set rules
- Transparent decision making process / governance votes
- → Clearly defined rules for membership
